CLASSIC AND SPECIALTY CAR CRUISE NIGHTS BY: MEG COSS

The year is 1964. The Beatles top the Billboard charts, "Bonanza" plays on TV, Muhammad Ali defeats Sonny Liston for the heavyweight title, and moviegoers around the world catch the car bug as James Bond pursues Goldfinger in a specially equipped, gadget laden, silver birch Aston Martin DB5

"The first car that caught my eye? I'd have to say James Bond's Aston Martin. That's a vehicle you don't forget," says Tim Connelly. Connelly coordinates and organizes Classic and Specialty Car Cruise Nights, Misquamicut's weekly summer showcase of classic, specialty, and vintage cars.

In recent years, Cruise Nights have seen an upsurge in attendance, drawing crowds of all ages and genders eager to exhibit and admire automotive marvels from yesteryear to today.

"We had a brand new McLaren last year. Everybody's eyes popped when they saw it," says Connelly. "We're seeing brand new Corvettes and these specialty vehicles with high horsepower. We're seeing monster trucks, too. Really anything that's unique."

Cruise Nights take place every Tuesday from 5:30pm to dusk at the Misquamicut Drive-In Theater from July through August. Depending on the weather, attendees can expect to see up to 100 head-turning vehicles, including Corvettes, Mustangs, Morgans, Bel Airs, Willys trucks, and one of Connelly's favorite hot rods.

"There's a gentleman who

comes in who has, I believe it's a '22 Mustang, he's an auto body specialist, so he has the ability to customize vehicles. He took all the body panels off a newer Mustang and then replaced them all, I believe with a '55 Ford. So you see this low slung '55 Ford coupe come pulling in with a rumble and then you come up to the vehicle and look inside and it's a brand new car. It's incredible. The engineering that went into converting this. It's unbelievable what people can do. The sky's limit."

In addition to head-turning hot rods, Cruise Nights are backed with a vibe-setting soundtrack from Dom Cardillo AKA "The Doc," and Pat Cole, the on-air talent from 102.3FM The Wolf, which broadcasts weekly from the Drive-In. This summer marks Cardillo's 40th year DJ-ing car shows, and although he has a soft spot for classic tunes, he spins the hits from all decades.

"You start with "Duke of Earl" then going forward, a little bit later, there's Aerosmith, and then today it's Taylor Swift. We're versatile. We have songs like "Low Rider" by War, and "Little Deuce Coupe" by the Beach Boys. There are so many different songs. Oldsmobile songs. Virtually any make and model has a song."

Connelly and Cardillo are Chevy guys, but Connelly would take a '68 Fastback Mustang if the occasion presented itself, and although Cardillo's marina blue '67 396 Camaro is his pride and joy, he says he likes them all — Mopars, Fords, you name it. The two also share a



fondness for the nostalgia and joy classic cars provide.

"When you're driving around and you see a car that's an antique or a classic, just looking at it brings you back in time. I know it does for me, and I think it does for a lot of people," says Connelly. "And if you're lucky enough to own one, or you're able to drive one, it really takes you back. It's special because you pull up to a light and people stare at you and you get the waves and the thumbs up, and you're getting the horns honked at you you're putting smiles on faces"

Each Cruise Night includes a raffle where all participants can enter to win an assortment of prizes ranging from gift cards to car wash supplies to the weekly grand prize of \$250.

"The decision was made not to judge," says Connelly. "My reasoning behind that was, we need the everyday man here. We can't just have the guys who have money showing up with their beautiful vehicles. We need the everyday man we gotta make this approachable.

So we have a raffle, and that means anybody can win, like the kid who shows up with his vehicle that he loves."

Connelly is grateful for the support of the Misquamicut Business Association for keeping "the heartbeat of the Classic Cruise Nights beating" and for the financial support of its sponsors, including Guytanno's restaurant and 102.3FM The Wolf, who help keep this tradition alive.

"A lot of us were brought up with this type of thing. People who are into cars, motorcycles, what have you, this is a tradition that goes way back. It goes way back in my family with my brother, my dad, even my mom," says Connelly. "When my mom was vounger she had an old T-Bird, I think it was a '57. After my dad passed, she had one of those moments where she just decided she would go out and buy that '57 T-Bird again. So she went out and bought it — a candy apple red T-Bird. This is a tradition we need to keep alive. I'm really honored to be involved."





For John Bellone, growing up in the Breezeway Motel was a lot of fun. He explains, "As a kid, I thought it was normal to have a 30 car parking lot to ride your bike around in." When his family bought the property and moved in, Bellone was only nine months old. He lived there until he went off for college, returning again for a few years after getting his degree, until he bought a house of his own. In many ways, his life has been immersed in running a hotel, and making one feel like home.

His parents Maria and Nicola emigrated to New England from Tusa, Sicily. They first settled inland, in Connecticut, where Maria soon grew homesick living away from the ocean. The young family moved again, this



time to Westerly, where they lived in a small house on Saunders Road. Nicola worked as a mason. One day, on his drive to work, he saw a "For Sale" sign posted on the Breezeway Motel. Maria and Nicola bought the property, moving the family there to live.

I asked John if he thought his parents had the intention to continue operating the Breezeway as a motel when they purchased it. He laughs and replies honestly: "I don't know what they were thinking. I wonder about that myself to this day."

When visitors stay at the Breezeway, they can expect clean, modern accommodations with the charm of a property maintained by a family over generations. Just a short walk from Breezeway's private beach, John notes that the secluded locale is like a tranquil park. He tells me about a historic feature of the motel as well — the day that his father signed the final documents to purchase the property, he built a chimney in the motel that stands to this day. His father also originally built fountains in the yard, combining his skills as a stonemason with his new venture in hospitality to create a little slice of paradise.

Decades after Breezeway opened, Maria went out on a walk along Misquamicut beach, as she often did. Much like her husband on his drive to work years earlier, she idly noticed

that a restaurant along the beach, Dino's Seafood House, was up for sale. The couple bought the restaurant, which included five apartments in the upstairs portion of the building. Soon, they opened Maria's Seaside Cafe.

Unfortunately, the cafe suffered severe damage from Superstorm Sandy in 2012. Sadly, Maria was not able to see the restaurant's rebuild completed, as she passed away in 2014.

Today, Maria's Seaside Cafe stands as a testament to the sacrifice and hard work that Maria dedicated over the course of her life to her family, their business, and the Misquamicut community. Situated off the lobby of The Hotel Maria, also her namesake, the cafe carries on the legacy of her original restaurant. The about section on The Hotel Maria's website poignantly notes, "Rebuilding was easy, losing her wasn't. Maria passed away on October 11, 2014."

John is eager to emphasize the story of his family's legacy built over the past half of a century. He weaves the memory of his family's past into the present success of the Breezeway Resort, The Hotel Maria, and Maria's Seaside Cafe. Maria's love of the beach brought the family to Misquamicut and that decision has had lasting effects on not only their family, but on the countless families who have stayed at either of their hotels or dined at their restaurant.

John says he didn't necessarily expect to work in hospitality like his parents while he was growing up. Despite the odd hours and the seasonal nature of the business, he enjoys what



he does, specifically the satisfaction of keeping patrons happy and fed. He's passionate about maintaining the integrity of the place where he grew up, as well as the businesses he has continued to build in his mother and father's honor.



Shortly after the devastating hurricane of 1938, Cosmo Sisco had an idea for a new business venture. Cosmo was a dreamer, or better yet, a visionary. He convinced his wife, Christine Sisco, that they should open a hot dog stand in Misquamicut. Using the old wood from an outhouse on Christine's family homestead on Tower Street, they built Dicky's Hot Dog Stand in Misquamicut on the property now known as Wuskenau Town Beach.

Dicky's was the first to feature the original foot long hot dog. They sold so many that the bun company had to park a trailer full of buns next to the building! The stand was named after their first born son, Richard "Dicky" Sisco and the name is still used to this day by local surfers as one of towns favorite surf spots. This risky venture paid off and soon they opened two additional hot dog stands named after their other two boys, Bobby's

and Billy Ted's. Dicky's Hot Dog Stand soon evolved into Dicky's Bar & Grill, complete with a beer garden, television, and a visit from the famous Johnny Roventini, the spokesman and bellboy for Phillip Morris commercials. After a few vears of operation, the Sisco's sold Dicky's Bar & Grill to the Risica's and headed to the west end of Misquamicut to open the infamous Sisco's General Store.

Sisco's was opened in 1952 where the current Hotel Maria stands now. The general store was known as the store with everything, including a luncheonette, candy, cigarettes, fireworks, souvenirs, groceries, pony rides and even a gas station. Sisco's was featured in the LA Times as a classic business operation with everything from soup to nuts! Hurricane Carol came along in 1954 and seriously damaged the relatively new building. Needless to say, The Sisco's were not going to let that deter them, they soon

rebuilt and were ready to go the next season. Sisco's was also mentioned on the Dating Game Show when two contestants stated that they met at Sisco's General Store in Misquamicut, RI! Sisco's soared in popularity as a staple of Misquamicut and a place where many Misquamicut families shopped on a regular basis. Their 3 boys, Dicky, Bobby and Billy all worked with their parents around the clock to satisfy the demand.

Remember, back then there were no grocery stores nearby, no Walmart, no Stop and Shop. In 1966, sadly, Cosmo Sisco passed away from a heart attack. Christine and her son Bobby, carried the torch and ran the store as it always was. In the early 70's, so as not to lose the neighborhood business zoning on a property on Shore Road, Bobby had the idea to open a yearround business to complement the seasonal Sisco's General. In 1972 the idea came to fruition, Shorecrest

Country Store was established! Shorecrest Country Store was located on the corner of Shore Rd(1A) and Crandall Avenue, right across the street from Christine Sisco's home where an old barn once stood. Dick Sisco came up with the name by combining shore(sea) with crest(wave). Shorecrest Country Store was another general store that had everything from groceries, gift shop, hardware, souvenirs, and a full service deli complete with seafood, fresh meats, cold cuts and delicious grinders. Christine helped in the off season, while Bobby and his wife, Margo, ran Shorecrest.

In 1983, Bobby decided to expand by building two wings on the existing building that would house other retail units, called Shorecrest Village. We currently are home to Misquamicut Sandwich Company, Shorecrest Store, Seaside Hair Studio, Onshore Realtors and William T. Sisco, CPA. Shorecrest celebrated its 50th anniversary back

in 2022 and is currently run by Bobby, Margo and their daughter Holly. Sisco's General sadly closed in 1999, after almost 50 years in business, when Christine suffered a mild stroke and could no longer run the store. Christine passed away at the age of 89 and is remembered as a tough business woman with a

The Sisco Family has been in Misquamicut for over 80 years and is proud to share this with other family legacy's like the Colucci Family at the Andrea, the Trefes' at the Windjammer/Bayview Fun Park and the Terranova Family at the Pleasant View. We have seen many Misquamicut businesses come and go over the

vears, cottages change from small homes with outdoor showers only, to mini mansions with all the bells and whistles. We have seen many storms, both hurricanes and powerful winter storms, that cause major damage to our beautiful beaches, the lifeblood of Misquamicut. But like the phoenix, they will rise. Misquamicut will always be our home and we sincerely hope that we can be in business for another 50 years! RELATIVELY SPEAKING - STARFISH, SAND DOLLARS, AND SEA URCHINS

Some rather unusual creatures live just off the beach in the shallow waters up and down our coast.

These little ocean animals belong to a group called ECHINODERMS.

Please don't be alarmed by that big scientific word. It refers to the texture of their skin, which can be very spiked, rough and bumpy, or rather velvety.

After heavy storms we can occasionally find these poor little things stranded upon the sand. We know them as starfish, sand dollars and sea urchins.

They are all members of the same group.

If you find a starfish, pick it up gently. The upper surface is a bit rough feeling. Turn it upside down and you will discover hundreds of soft little wiggling straw-like tubes arranged in rows on the starfish legs. These strange little things are called TUBE FEET. The starfish brings in water through the tube feet. It then pumps the water out through a special place on the top of the body. This creates a suction which allows the starfish to cling tightly to rocks or clams or oysters.

Using this suction system, a starfish can pull clam shells apart. This is hard work, but once the clam or oyster gets tired the two shells begin to separate. The starfish can now do something quite unexpected. The starfish mouth is on the underside of the body, right in the center. Now it will squeeze its stomach right out of the mouth and insert it into the partially opened clam. It digests the clam then pulls its stomach back into its body. Yum!

Starfish, of course, are not fish at all. We should correctly call them SEA STARS.

Sand Dollars are quite flat and are usually circular in shape like a white coin. There is a little mouth opening underneath which allows them to eat tiny things they find in the sand. Often when we find sand dollars, they have lost their velvety covering and appear to be hard and white. They usually have a pretty design of very tiny holes on top that looks like a flower. Also, if you break a sand dollar open you will find five small bony pieces called "doves". They look like tiny flying birds. Actually they helped chew the food the sand dollar takes in.

Finally, sea urchins. These creatures look like a fat pin cushion with the points sticking out. They burrow along, digging little depressions in the sand as they hunt for food or digging deep to shelter from storms.

When urchins die all the spines fall off and we discover the "test" which is the hard rounded white



inner surface under their skin.

All echinoderms are able to regenerate lost body parts. Cut off a starfish leg and it will grow a new one.

Long ago people who harvested clams and oysters would collect starfish, then chop them up to kill them and throw the bits and pieces back into the ocean. Alas, the larger pieces grew back their missing parts. Even more starfish resulted.

Some specialty items available include churros, fried Oreos and Twinkies, and donuts. She describes some of the offerings as follows:
